Day Pass for Visitor Sailors

The club has a new option for skippers to obtain a Day Pass for day visitors that they may have as a crew on their boats. This is a digital option instead of filling in the paperwork at the club. By completing a Day Pass using this digital option, the visitor receives a Yachting Australia Number and easier access if they wish to sail multiple times. The link to this Day Pass will be available from the Clubs' Website, so ask your visitor to access the link via their phone, and follow the 4 steps to complete the registration. It is also an option to complete this task at home prior to heading out sailing. The information Yachting Australia requires for a Day Pass is an email address, name, address, contact number, and DOB. The Committee have set a limit of 5 Day Passes per person allowable, prior to being required to gain membership with the Club. There is an internet link to complete a day pass registration, it will be available to be accessed via the Clubs website soon.

Members are encouraged to take note of the position of our defibrillator which is hanging on the wall just inside club office.


